SENIOR PROGRESS BADGE SCHEME

Introduction:

The Audco Archers progress award scheme is designed to help you practice your shooting at different distances and recognise your achievements.

It is very similar to award schemes in use at many other archery clubs across the UK and is suitable for all archers irrespective of age, ability or bow type. It can also be used as an easy introduction to competing in tournaments at a later date.

The Rules:

- Archery GB “Rules of Shooting” apply.
- For the score to be valid, six sighting arrows only are allowed, followed immediately three dozen scored arrows and it must be the first shoot of the day.
- Scoring: Imperial - 5 zone scoring (Gold = 9, Red = 7, Blue = 5, Black = 3, White = 1, Miss = M) using 122cm target face.
- Distances are shown in the table below along with the amount of qualifying scores required.
- Purple badge: Ladies shoot at 80 yards; Gents shoot at 100 yards.
- Badges are to be claimed in ascending distance order, once you start at a distance you cannot go back to the shorter distances to claim previous badges.
- Experienced archers to start at a minimum of 30 yards.
- Qualifying scores for a given distance must be shot on different days.
- **Please ensure that all fields on the scoresheet are correctly completed.**
- To make an award claim, the signed and witnessed score sheets need to be submitted to the Records Officer (Rebecca Bodkin) or Club Secretary (Paul Nelms).
