INDOOR ROUNDS

Introduction:

The Rules:

- Archery GB "Rules of Shooting" apply.
- For the score to be valid, six sighting arrows only are allowed in ends of three followed immediately by the scoring arrows and it must be the first shoot of the day.
- Rounds are shot at various distances as instructed below.
- Scoring: 10 zone Scoring (10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1,M (Miss) for all round except for the Worcester Round.
- *** Worcester Round Scoring: 5 Zone Scoring (5,4,3,2,1 M) (Miss).***
- The chart below shows the number of dozen at each distance. Please note the difference on the Worcester round.
- All archers shoot the same distance, regardless of age or bow discipline.
- **Please ensure that all fields on the scoresheet are correctly completed.**
- Scoresheets must be signed and witnessed and need to be submitted to the Scoresheet Post-box in the Hall for the attention of the Records Officer Neil Wright or email records@audcoarchers.com

*** The table below lists all the recognised indoor rounds, again with arrows counted by the dozen (except for the Worcester Round as arrows are shot 5 arrows per end).***
